(The essay should not exceed the word limit. This would lead to disqualification.)

## 3. The entry should be original. Plagiarism would not be accepted.

4. Participants are to make sure that they write their name, class and section on every page of the entry.

5.Declaration must be submitted along with the entry, failing which entry will be summarily rejected.

#### **MODE OF SUBMISSION**

The essay should be written in neat and legible handwriting. The participants should submit the hand-written write-up as an attachment through email to *aejcmumcca@gmail.com*.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR THE PARENT PARTICIPANTS**

1. Parents who wish to participate can send entries in English, Hindi and Marathi. (ONE ENTRY per language)

2. Word Limit for the Essay: within 500 - 600 words

(The essay should not exceed the word limit. This would lead to disqualification.)

3. The entry should be original. Plagiarism would not be accepted.

4. Participants are to make sure that they write the name and address on the entry.

5. Participants should submit the duly filled self-declaration form along with the entry.

6.Declaration must be submitted along with the entry, failing which entry will be summarily rejected.
