# Atomic Energy Junior College, Anushaktinagar, <u>Mumbai-400094</u> <u>Admission FYJC (XI):2023-2024</u> <u>Admission Circular (For Non-DAE Wards only)</u> <u>DATE: 28-6-2023</u>

Admissions are open for NON-DAE wards (ND-1 to ND-4), who have passed class10<sup>th</sup> either in CBSE, MS Board or any equivalent boards. AEJC offers admission to Science and Commerce stream. In the science stream there are options as listed below. The admission is based on the guidelines issued by MS Board. Students, passing through CBSE/ICSE/NIOS are expected to submit migration certificate.

Grant of admission in AEJC, Mumbai is subject to availability of seats in respective stream after completion of DAE admissions. Categories of Non-DAE wards for seeking admission against vacant seats, if any is as follows:

ND-3	Grandchildren of serving/retired or expired DAE employee (one admission per employee). Grandchildren of AEES employees (serving/retired or expired) will have preference.		
ND-4	Wards of people residing around DAE establishment		

### **Eligibility Norms**

- i. The criterion for admission are based on the norms framed by the Department of Education, Govt. of Maharashtra and adopted by the Governing Council of Atomic Energy Education Society from time to time,
- ii. Admission to the Candidates from other Boards/States to FYJC in AEJC is purely provisional subject to the approved **Eligibility** of the applicant from M.S. Board, Mumbai,
- iii. CandidatemusthavepassedinfivesubjectswithEnglishasoneofthesubjectinAISSE/SSCE.
- iv. Marks and Subject Criteria:
  - a. For Science and Vocational (on Merit Basis) Minimum pass marks in AISS/SSC Examination and candidate must have passed in Science at AISS/SSCE.
  - b. For Commerce Minimum pass marks in AISS/SSC Examination.
  - c. Admission for Science, Vocational and Commerce course of **FYJC** (**Std. XI**) will be strictly on merit and will be restricted to the number of seats that would be available.

#### ##Vocational subjects have two papers

#### \*Eligibility Certificate

Candidates, who have passed Class X Exam from other board i.e. other than Maharashtra Board and are seeking admission in FYJC at AEJC, Mumbai are required to submit ORIGINAL filled-in Application form for Eligibility Certificate through AEJC (whenever the same is asked) along with the required enclosures viz.

- a. Copiesof(TC/SLC)dulycountersignedbyappropriateauthorityinrelevantcasesasper rules,
- b. Photo copy of original Marksheet of ClassX,
- c. Original Migration Certificate from the board,
- d. Deed of undertaking on the stamp paper at appropriate time as given by the Office, as per updated norms of the Board.
- e. CopyofMarksStatementandPassingCertificateshouldbesubmittedimmediatelyafterreceivingf rom the board\*\*.

The Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education issues a Provisional **Eligibility Certificate** after receiving the above mentioned documents.

\*\*It will be obligatory on the part of the students to collect the passing certificate and Migration certificate from the respective School/Jr. College, on receipt of the same from CBSE/ICSE or other state boards and submit the same to **AEJC**, **Mumbai in time** for submission to **Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education**, **Vashi**, **Navi Mumbai**, to get the Final **Eligibility Certificate**. Without Final Eligibility Certificate student/s will not be entitled to appear for the final exams. If they are permitted to take the exams, their results will not be declared and they will not be promoted to **SYJC (Class XII)** without the final **Eligibility Certificate** as per Board rules. Please note that the MS board imposes fine on late submission of Eligibility form and required documents as per the rules laid by MS board from time to time.

#### Note:

- i. Those students who opt for Vocational Group must clearly indicate the vocational subject of their **First, Second and Third Preference**. If they don't indicate their **Second and Third Preference**, it will be considered that they do not want any other Vocational subject. If they do not get the subject opted for, against **First Preference**, they will be automatically considered for the **Science Group with Biology**.
- ii. If order of preference of stream is not given, the candidates will be considered only with the option given by him/her. If no option is given, the candidate will be considered for commerce stream only.

#### Instructions to the students regarding admission

- 1. Exercise all the options as per your choice given in on line process. Later **no claim** will be entertained for change of choice. Option of subject/stream is the subject to the vacancy in respective stream.
- 2. After the display of approved Merit List, students should pay the fees (on line) for the stream offered, otherwise they will not be considered for better choice in the consecutive lists and no claim will be entertained in this regard thereafter.
- 3. Fee structure and amount to be paid is available in Admission Circular (<u>www.aees.gov.in</u>). Misc. Fees is displayed on the AEJC website (<u>www.aejcmumbai.ac.in</u>).
- 4. Submission of (class X) Original **TC** along with the original fee receipt paid through online in college is mandatory for confirmation of admission. Fee payment through on line alone does not confirm admission. If the confirmed admission is cancelled due to any reason, the Old T.C (class X) will not be issued, instead college will issue new T.C and the claim of fee refund will be as per AEES Refund rules,
- 5. No claim of old TC will be entertained, if the admission is cancelled.
- 6. No claim of Admission will be entertained, and it is the subject to approval from competent authority.

- 8. Self Attested Photo copy of the caste certificate in case of SC/ST/VJ/NT/SBC & OBC communities in the name of the students issued by Executive Magistrate Tahsildar and revalidated in Maharashtra, if from other state.

- 10. Self Attested Photocopies of Certificates of NCC, Scout and Intermediate Drawing Examination, participation in Sports and cultural activities at state/national level and selection

in INMO.

- 12. Undertakings on Fee collection as per the enclosed/prescribed proforma (Original).
