1. Environment Education (EE) includes water conservation (Jal Suraksha). Project work should be recorded in the project book prescribed by the MS board. Project report and Journal work carries 50 marks which will be converted into grades.
2. Health and Physical Education (HPE) will have Theory in the first term for 25 marks for duration of 1.5 hrs and Practical in the second terms for 25 marks. Total marks include theory and practical for 50 marks which will be converted into grades.
3. Exams in EE and HPE is compulsory for all students irrespective of the streams.
