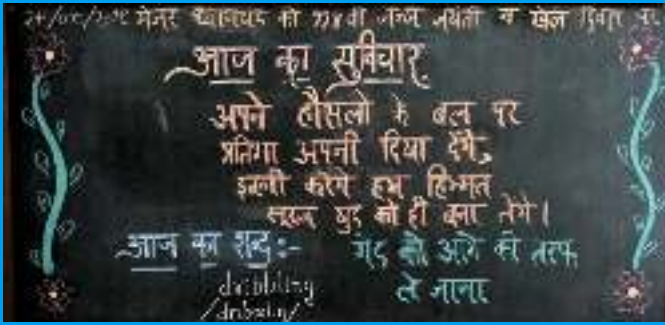


INDEPENDENCE DAY 2019

Talent Galore



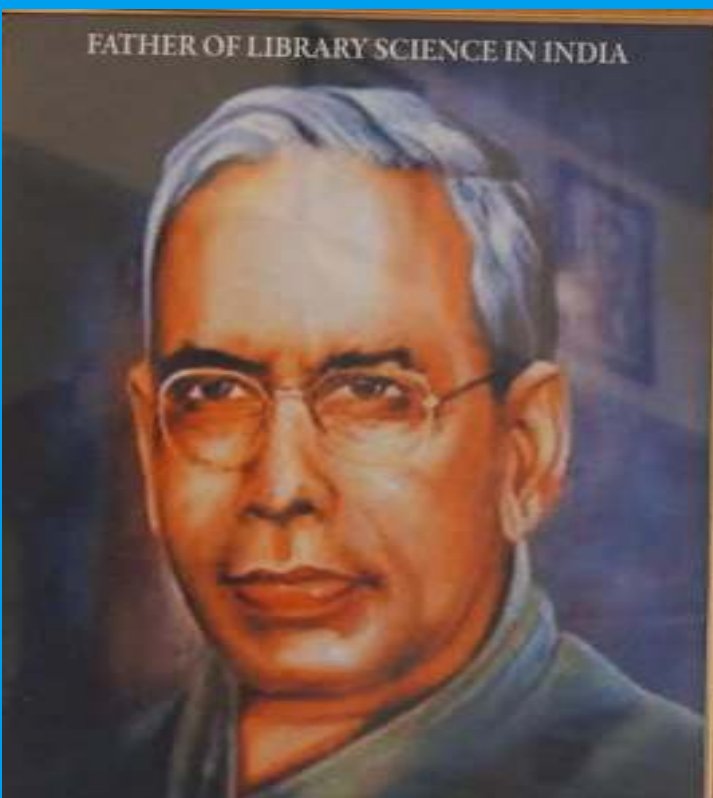

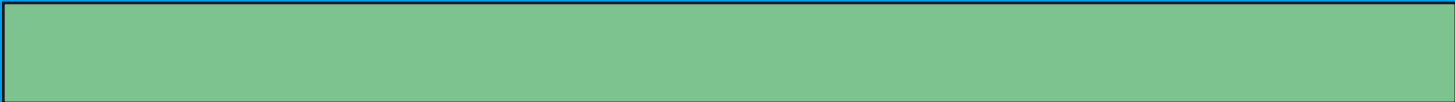
AAINA of College - 2019
